Foreword

Photography is the youngest art, so young, in fact, that it is not often recognized as an art. What has hindered photography's "coming of age" more than anything else is that most people think of and use a camera as a toy. If this exhibit contributes anything to photography's status as a serious art, it will have accomplished its purpose. Sponsored by the Louisville Camera Club, the exhibit of photographs shown in the first group, numbers 1 to 75, inclusive, is the work of amateur photographers of Louisville and other areas of the Falls Cities. The second group, numbers 1 to 29, inclusive, which comes as a Traveling Loan Exhibit from the California Camera Club of San Francisco, has been brought on by our Louisville Camera Club for the purposes of comparison.
